

Walker Instructions

Collect Your Sponsors' Donations

Ask your friends, relatives, co-workers, classmates, etc., to make a contribution to the GRACE Hunger Walk to help in the fight against hunger. If possible, sponsors should pay by check when they pledge, and all monies should be collected in advance of the Walk. Make checks payable to: GRACE Hunger Walk. Return Walker Envelope

Return your envelope to your recruiter/coordinator with the money you have collected by Sunday, April 25, or bring it to the Walk. It's VERY important to completely fill out Walker Information on reverse side and sign the waiver. If you would like a copy of your sponsors, please make a photocopy before turning in your envelope.

Walk Day - Saturday, May 1, 2010 • 8:00 am Check-In • 8:30 am Walk Start

- The walk begins at First United Methodist Church, 207 E. Fulton at Barclay.
- We encourage you to come in groups to simplify parking.
- Go directly to the Check-In Table. You need to be counted!
- Turn in your envelope (if you haven't turned it in to your recruiter) and receive a map.
- 8:00 a.m. Check-in Begins - coffee/refreshments provided; find your group.
- 8:30 a.m. Walk Starts - rain or shine!

While You Are Walking

- You are expected to observe all regular traffic rules and signs.
- Wear comfortable walking shoes and clothing appropriate for the weather. WE WALK RAIN OR SHINE.
- Walk at your own pace, as far as you wish. If necessary, buses or vans will be at checkpoints to take you back to the park.
- Portable toilet facilities will be located at intervals along the route.
- We request that elementary aged children be accompanied by an adult.
- If you want to use bicycles, in-line skates or skateboards, please plan on starting early to protect the walkers.

After the Walk

Collect any outstanding pledges as soon as possible and give them to either your recruiter/coordinator, any Chase branch or mail to the GRACE office, 183 Lakeside Dr. NE, Grand Rapids, MI 49503 by June 1st, 2010.
